

### **Explorer Leadership Academy 2018 General Information**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Explorer Leadership Academy, the first of its kind in the State of Wisconsin, is designed to be an introduction for law enforcement explorers to the core concepts of leadership. A few of the topics covered will be basic leadership concepts, leadership styles, communication, ethics and practical techniques. The training will be in a classroom setting with a variety of presenters and group activities. In class participation is encouraged to get the most out of the program.

The course will take place at Waukesha County Technical College located at 800 Main St. Room S235 Pewaukee, WI 53072 on Saturday October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

The training day will run as follows-

0730-0800 hrs Registration

0800-Noon Training

Noon-1300 hrs Lunch and tour of WCTC facilities

1300- 1630 hrs Training

Snacks, drinks and lunch will be provided throughout the day and are included in the registration price. Lunch will be provided. We will have breaks every 45 minutes or so.

Uniforms are not permitted so there will be no hesitancy of explorers who don't have rank within their posts to participate. Post t-shirts are allowed. Dress will be casual, appropriate clothing. No hats or torn, dirty clothing please. No duty belts or equipment other than a pen and a pad of paper is required.

Advisors are permitted to attend, but are NOT required to attend as this is an explorer training event. If an advisor wishes to attend they will be required to pay the registration as well.
